<p>isoporbiter</p>  A collection of white, porous polystyrene foam fragments of various sizes and shapes.	<p>tau/garnrester</p>  A tangled mass of colorful synthetic fishing lines and ropes in shades of orange, red, yellow, and blue.	<p>leker</p>  A bright green, multi-lobed plastic toy, possibly a frog or a similar animal-shaped object.	<p>haglepatroner</p>  Four shotgun shells in different colors: green, blue, red, and black.
<p>q-tips</p>  A bundle of blue and white Q-tips (cotton swabs) lying on a light surface.	<p>biofilmfilter</p>  Several small, white, circular mesh filters, likely used for water filtration.	<p>ballongrester</p>  A collection of colorful, tangled balloons and strings, including purple, blue, red, and orange.	<p>uidentifiserbar plastbit</p>  A small, clear plastic container filled with various pieces of unidentifiable plastic waste.
<p>flaskekork</p>  A collection of plastic bottle caps in various colors: green, white, red (Coca-Cola), and blue.	<p>sko</p>  A single, light-colored, woven shoe with a pinkish-red interior and a small pink detail.	<p>sprengtråd</p>  A bundle of colorful, thin, fibrous strings or threads in shades of yellow, pink, and green.	<p>godteripapir</p>  A collection of crumpled candy wrappers, including a blue and yellow wrapper and a green wrapper with the word 'Extra' visible.
<p>kanne</p>  A large, clear plastic jug or container with a handle and a green string tied around the neck.	<p>flaske</p>  Two clear plastic bottles, one larger and one smaller, both with labels and caps.	<p>lighter</p>  A blue and white lighter and a white lighter with a red tip.	<p>snusboks</p>  A dark, circular, textured tin or container, possibly for snuff or tobacco.
